Webersburg Estate lies in the heart of the Cape's most famous wine region. The site was first planted with vines in 1693. Their prized low yield, 94 acre Stellenbosch vineyard is meticulously hand harvested. Winemaker Giorgio Dalla Cia then follows classic French traditions: carefully controlled fermentation, gentle handling and extended aging in new French oak barrels, followed by at least one year of bottle aging.

Elegance, finesse and complexity are the Webersburg trademarks. These wines are true classics; coveted by those who appreciate the finest reds.

Cabernet Sauvignon

100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Low production per hectare, controlled fermentation followed by 18 months in 70% new and 30% second year French oak barrels. A high percentage of new barrels every vintage gives the wine great structure and complexity with great finesse and good aging potential. Elegant and classic in the style of great Bordeaux wines. Silky tannins and good balance, well rounded and lingering on the palate. Mouth filling with a smokey, toffee character. Can be enjoyed now or bottle age a further 5 years.

Cabernet / Merlot

"Iron fist in a silk glove," is how Giorgio describes this robust, yet elegant wine which spent 18 months in small French oak barrels.

An exceptionally opulent, complex blend. The marriage between these two noble varietals results in an integration of rich cassis fruit woven into smooth plush tannins. On the nose there are ample tones of chocolate, violets, wild berries and vanilla spice. Very masculine in character, the leatheriness and black olives of the Cabernet complimenting the cherries and boiled beetroot of the Merlot, this is a well balanced wine with a long lingering aftertaste. Elegant and refined, allow time to decant, unfurl and open up. Enjoy now or bottle age 3-5 years for added complexity.
