Gôiya, 1.5L, Olifants River Region, South Africa

Varietal:

100% Shiraz 2004

Vinification:

The red wines are produced at Vredendal Cellars, while the whites are vinted at Spruitdrift Cellars. This gives their separate staffs of winemakers the opportunity to focus on a limited number of wines, growers and vineyards. The wines are cold stabilized, fermented and aged in massive stainless steel containers, to highlight the bright fruit flavors. This ensures consistent quality and fresh, crisp tasting wines. All bottling and labeling is done in these facilities.

Tasting Notes:

Balanced spice, plum and cherry fruit on a medium-bodied frame. Dry and slightly spicy on the finish. Very enjoyable when paired with spicy food and BBQ dishes.
