Varietal:

100% Shiraz 2004

Vinification:



Hand harvested from vineyards located in Riebeek, Paarl and Wellington. Conventional stainless steel pump over fermentation. 10% matured 12 months in French oak, 65% stave maturation, 25 % no wood.

Tasting Notes:

Smoky raspberry and black cherry flavors with a sprinkle of spice and white pepper tones. Full bodied, soft plush tannins with a very satisfying finish. Most enjoyable when paired with most grilled foods and spicy dishes. Ready to drink now or bottle age a further 5 years for added complexity.
