Serengeti, 750ml, Swartland District, South Africa

Varietal:

60% Cabernet Sauvignon - 40% Merlot 2003

Vinification:


About 37 miles north of Cape Town are the dry- farmed, low- yield Swartland vineyards that provide 6-8 tons of premium fruit per hectare (2.5-3 tons per acre) for Serengeti. These vineyards are hand harvested, the juice gently fermented and then aged in 300- liter French oak barrels to optimize the natural fruit flavors and complexity.

Tasting Notes:

A Bordeaux style blend of two of the world's most sought after grapes. An attractive nose of hearth spices and violets leads to rich, plummy, soft fruit. The fruit of this medium to fuller wine gives way to the distinctive Malmsbury spices which echo through the moderate tannins. Well balanced - delightful with a steak - amazing with anything dark chocolate or savory desserts.
