100% Sauvignon Blanc 2005

Vinification:



About 37 miles north of Cape Town are the dry- farmed, low- yield Swartland vineyards that provide 6-8 tons of premium fruit per hectare (2.5-3 tons per acre) for Serengeti. This Sauvignon Blanc was aged and fermented in stainless steel tanks for 6 months prior to bottling.

Tasting Notes:

These vineyards are located in cool, hillside locations. This is a medium bodied, 100% Sauvignon Blanc filled with crisp citrus flavors - bursting with lime, grapefruit and gooseberries. It's a wonderful white wine to pair with pork, poultry or seafood. Especially good with oysters. If you want a crisp white wine for people suffering from the ABC's (anything but Chardonnay), make this your choice.
