 Serengeti, 750ml, Swartland District, South Africa

Varietal:  
 100% Shiraz 2003

Vinification:  
 About 37 miles north of Cape Town are the dry- farmed, low- yield Swartland vineyards that provide 6-8 tons of premium fruit per hectare (2.5-3 tons per acre) for Serengeti. This Shiraz was 50% tank aged and 50% barrel aged in two year old 300-liter French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes:  
 Shiraz is the fastest growing trend in the U.S. and one of the most widely planted new varieties in South Africa. One taste of this wine and you'll know why. This wine has nice, bright fruit flavors including blackberries and red fruits. The aftertaste has hints of white pepper interwoven with firm tannins but the overall finish is smooth. Enjoy this wine with spicy foods, lamb, prime rib, grilled meats and medium bodied cheeses.
